Qualifications

- Thorough knowledge of the sport of baseball, including knowledge of softball fundamentals, strategy, skill development, and team chemistry/player relationships.
- Possess motivational, organizational, and leadership skills.
- Ability to communicate positively with students, staff, parents, community, media, and coaches.
- Demonstrate knowledge of ASB fundraising and budget management.
- Ability to teach and empower the coaching staff with all aspects of the sport of softball.
- Develop and manage a summer program including camps for all ages.
- Possess an ability to develop students to accomplish the following:
 - Understanding the importance of teamwork and discipline
 - Believe in themselves and their teammates
 - Be dedicated to the sport, the team, and towards personal growth as an athlete and citizen
 - Feel valued, respected, and involved
 - Inspires student-athletes to pursue both academics and athletics to better themselves and to encourage sportsmanship
- Must obtain or hold a current First Aid/CPR card and meet WIAA coaching standards for beginning coach.
- Must meet all employment requirements for the Wellpinit School District, including fingerprinting.
- Position is not paid unless there is 12 or more athletes
